Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility and notification that we received confirmation yesterday that a staff member and a resident tested positive for COVID-19, which brings our total number of confirmed cases to 4 (1 resident and 3 staff members). The positive resident was discharged to another SNF with no further complications. One staff member has returned and 2 others will return within a week. We continue to test as per CDC guidelines.

As you have probably heard, the CDC recently announced that healthcare workers and long-term care residents should be among the first group of people to receive the vaccine for COVID-19. We are optimistic this will help stop the spread of this virus in our community. Consents for the vaccines are currently available and while we do not have the exact dates that the vaccines will be administered, we will let you know as soon as that information is available. In the meantime, please continue to do your part in limiting the transmission of COVID-19 by wearing masks, washing your hands and keeping a safe distance from others.

We are also working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Today we received notification 1 resident has tested positive for COVID-19. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 2 residents and 7 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Both positive residents were transferred to another facility with no additional negative outcomes. All of our staff members are back to work and continue to be vigilant in our monitoring processes.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

On Monday 12/28/20 Residents & Staff received their 1st dose of the Pfizer vaccine. The 2nd required dose will be administered on 1/18/20 to Staff & Residents, completing the recommended vaccine process.
